Aakash distance learning program (NEET & JEE Result)

Apart from preparing students for board exams we also train them to face competitive exams after 12th. We have partnered-up with the Reach and Aakash distance learning programs to coach the students from 7th to 9th for NEET, JEE and NTSE exams.

Curriculum:

We strive for excellence in everything we do. Our learning environment allows every student to prosper as individuals. Excellence is our expectation and motto too.

To enhance holistic development, we follow a varied curriculum. They are specially chosen to fit the age group.

We follow Happy Tots in KinderGarten. It is a pioneer in early child care education.

Chrysalis is followed at the Primary level. It is a unique teaching-learning curriculum. In every 40-minute period children explore and habitually develop deep Cognitive intelligence, Social intelligence, Emotional intelligence, Metacognition and imbibe values.

At the middle and higher classes NCERT textbooks are followed. They offer in-depth knowledge of each subject, topic, and concept to students and let the students learn in an effective manner.

Special labs

We also offer additional learning programs such as Math Lab, E-Block – a technology-based language lab. Also, we have a Robotic lab to teach STEM concepts to students and School Cinema to equip children with skills to deal with everyday challenges.

Orientation Program for teachers

Our teaching faculty is the strongest. To enrich and update teaching methodology, subject wise orientation programs are conducted by subject resource persons who have well defined roles in their respective areas of expertise. Our teachers also sit for Teachers' Enrichment Test (TET) every month.

Teachers Workshop

To ensure the policy of VIJAY – The Joy of Learning - The school strongly believes in providing in house training for teachers throughout the year in different areas. All our staff members are involved in constant training and updates regarding academics and teaching methods to provide the best education to all the students.

Our Kindergarten teachers are trained in Happy Tots curriculum by Mrs Vijayalakshmi - Happy Tots trainer. She trained the teachers to extend motherly care to our blooming buds with many hands-on activities. Mrs Sharon, a well experienced KG in-charge, conducted a training session on storytelling and phonics. Communication training was also conducted for Kindergarten and primary level staff by Ms.Shainaz in the month of May from Jolly Phonics. Our Primary teachers were in fervent training by Mr.Kamalesh – National head of Chrysalis curriculum. He beautifully guided the teachers through teacher - student relationship, team building activities and teaching methods.

All the secondary teachers are trained by our own band of subject experts and resource persons from CBSE towards teaching and learning methods. Veenamani, Principal at chrysalis high, Bangalore, was invited to give an orientation programme on Questioning skill. An exclusive training session on Assessment and evaluation was conducted by our DPI Senior Principal Mrs. Yasotha ma'am.

Before I conclude, let me assure you that even though our students engage themselves in various co-curricular and life skill activities, top priority is given to academic performance. I render thanks to our management, our teaching and non-teaching staff, my students and parents who have been with us in all our activities with maximum support and cooperation.

Sports and Games

Our School has always been taking initiatives to get the best talent in the sports arena. We have consolidated the sports activities during school hours as extra - curricular activities where the school has recruited professional coaches for both fine arts and martial arts.
